I first was introduced to the music of "Rich Mullins" through our work with youth ministry. I was blessed by his music, and deeply touched by the message that resinated through his life. Rich was killed in a roll over accident in western Kansas several years ago. The book written by his friend, James Bryan Smith, has been called a "devotional biography", giving readers an insight into Rich's life, but more importantly, allowing the readers to learn what was most important to Rich – urging people to draw near to God. James did with "An Arrow Pointing to Heaven" what Rich did with his life, he told a story about God. Rich believed that God provides trying situations to help us grow. "It never fails, God will put people in your path that irritate you, especially if your're prone to be irritated". He will test us with struggles, and take us down the paths of suffering and sorrow that we may understand the paradox that these things can lead us to strength and growth. In the account of Joseph, God did not give Joseph a series of blessings, He gave him difficult circumstances:

God did not give Joseph any special information about how to get from being the son of a nomad in Palestine to being Pharaoh's right hand man in Egypt. What He did give Joseph was eleven

jealous brothers, the attention of a very loose and vengeful woman, the ability to do the service of interpreting dreams and managing other people's affairs, and the grace to do that faithfully wherever he was.

Though we would never ask for trying circumstances, if we are honest we will admit that those times in our lives when we struggled were our most transforming moments. In light of eternity, our suffering is momentary, and it works to shape us for an eternal weight of glory. Because he understood this, Rich learned to give thanks even for his pain. In his song "The agony and the Glory", he said:
*We give thanks for the sun,
We give thanks for the rain,
He is Lord of them all,
All the joy and the pain
We've gotta live
with the agony and the glory,
Through the pain and the joy,
We can learn to rejoice
And embrace both sides of the story,
Not a single moment goes to waste,
If it works to make you holy,
Let the Spirit have His way with you...
Through the the agony and the glory*
To be sure, struggles can break people if not endured with the power of faith. But Rich looked at the pain in his life and discovered the truth that

"In accepting what God wills for us...
...we find our peace."

Elderberries ...A True Kansas Blessing

Elderberries are quite edible. Gathered from the wild or commercially produced, the blue or purple berries are gathered and made into elderberry wine, jam, syrup, and pies. The entire flower clusters can be dipped in batter and fried while petals can be eaten raw or made into a fragrant and tasty tea. The flowers add an aromatic flavor and lightness to pancakes or fritters. The elderberry was well known value to the Indians of North America and the many purposes it serves. Throughout the months of July and August the small clusters of berries are ready to be harvested along many of the rural roadsides, a gift of the summer that our men always make sure to bring to our attention as they bring in buckets overflowing for our attention.
