June 30th, 2010 will be my last day at the office of USD 223. It seems like just yesterday that I started working part time, brought in because I knew how to run computers. That was the DOS age and records were moving from paper to electronic, and I was gifted with a natural ability to not only run and develop a program, but also the risk factor to tear those things apart, run lines through walls. I attribute it all to the savvy of being a country girl. At the time that I was offered the job as clerk of the board, replacing my mother who had served in the capacity since 1986, we spent the summer, cataloging and sorting files, cleaning the vault, and moving them to the History room. As we worked, she passed on tidbits of things that she knew, and where they were located, and she prepared me for the pressures of the job, that few people would ever understand. She shared with me the disappointment that she carried in her heart from sometimes witnessing the side of people that she wished she had not seen. Those experiences can make you cynical about people...she said.

In 2006 at the onset of my illness, Becky walked into my life...and I began to train her for the position that she assumed as

clerk this year. She had more training than I had ever had, but what I would share with her was something that is never taught in the formal training of school. Each step along the way, we worked through many tasks and situations that she would find herself involved in as clerk. As I shared with her what I mother had shared with me, I found myself adding to the advise a bit. The story I told her had to do with my grandson Kaden playing T Ball last year. Kaden was not the star of the team..in fact...sometimes, he was downright uncooperative. His moma said it would be a good experience for him, so she would set on the bench through the whole game, knowing that he would probably never play. She didn't care if others thought he was a bother, or were concern that the performance of their little star athlete would be effected by Kaden being allowed to play. However, the night that she called me from the

baseball diamond of a game that I could not attend, I will always remember her words..." Kaden played...and he ran the whole diamond...and everyone stood up and cheered! You see mom, you just have to give people a chance to do the right thing!". I cried like a baby. I guess life can make you cynical, you see people are people. That part of us that just thinks about ourselves is the human condition... SIN...it is why we need a Savior. And meanwhile, the story and advise that I will pass on to those that will keep the books after me has altered a bit. "Be realistic about people, but always give them the opportunity to do the right thing". It is the one thing on this side of Heaven that is ours to do...kind of like Jesus with skin on.
