A friend loaned a book to me the other day called "Out of the Deep", the account of a young father that lost his wife and four children in a flash flood by Emporia, Kansas. It was a very hard thing for me to read, however, his account did not focus on the personal tragedy, but on his thankfulness for the memories and the recollection of the circumstance that the Lord has allowed into his life from the time he was a child to prepare him for this event. He shares his faith and story with many....like me, who are reminded that this time on earth is but a whisper...and that Heaven is the prize...and the curtain between the two is very thin.
