Put your order in Early!

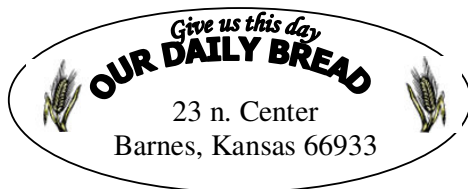
