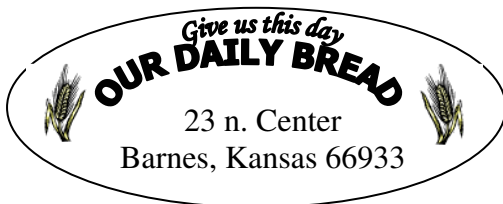
Passion Play
