This Sunday morning found me with a lack of the energy to go to church services. That happens sometimes, it is part of my limitations that I live with. I found myself sitting in my chair and enjoying one of my favorite authors. It is a rather short book, the only one that this author ever wrote, and it is only 14 chapters long. His name was Zechariah and the book is about starting over, remembering what we have forgotten, and returning to what is important. I found myself underlining and making notes along the sides of the pages. I often find that I will return there when I least expect it and enjoy the reference that I discovered on my last visit. Zechariah was a prophet. Prophets lived during the years when kings ruled Israel and Judah, and God spoke through them. Their primary role was to call God's people back to him. Haggai and Zechariah wrote their books around the time that the Jewish people returned from captivity in Babylon. "Return to me," declares the Lord God Almighty, 'and I will return to you'. Zechariah 1:3. Some would say that we as a nation have lost our way. We have more knowledge and gadgets than at any other time. I just spent the last hour trying to connect a friends scanner to a Vista Windows computer. Our founding fathers didn't have

such distractions. They knew their Bible well. I am sure that it was dog eared from reading and placing notes along the edge. They did not even have to reference God's Word in those original documents (even though they did) because their knowledge of that book was so much a part of them. Perhaps they knew that the prosperity and security of our Nation would depend on this constant message of the prophets found throughout the Bible. "And this is what the Lord Almighty says: 'Administer true justice; show mercy and compassion to one another. Do not oppress the widow or the fatherless, the alien or the poor. In your hearts do not think evil of each other.' Zechariah 7:8-10.
