Ernie just looked at me and said, "I'm glad to be home, but you need to understand – it would only take one word, and we would all be heading back there." Chris described it as "bringing hope where there is sometimes none – Love in a practical way is louder than words." Mark Olney, from Winfield Kansas was one of the volunteers that the guys got to know on the trip. In his words, "Until you literally walk through the neighborhoods you cannot fully appreciate the magnitude and devastation. Each evening I would walk in the immediate area surrounding the church. I was overcome with emotion, I would call my wife Pam on my cell phone, and she could sense in my voice the effect it had on me. There was no normalcy within my surroundings. No children playing, no one out for a leisurely walk or jog, no birds, cats, or dogs. It seemed every other house had condemned posters nailed to the exterior wall. But morning came soon. We woke with a new sense of urgency with the energy to get started. We were amazed by

how appreciative everyone was. We all felt that we had been blessed by the many people who we had come to help. One of our leaders said, "Our mission was to help people rebuild their houses but our goal was to share the love of Christ." I hadn't thought of it like that but from that day on my eyes, ears, and heart were opened. The love of Christ was everywhere." Chris offered these thoughts, "If there is a reason, that this devastation was allowed to happen, I believe that it may be to draw us all closer to Him. After all – the things of this world will pass away, but the people have eternal value."

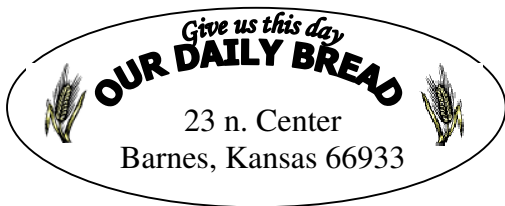
