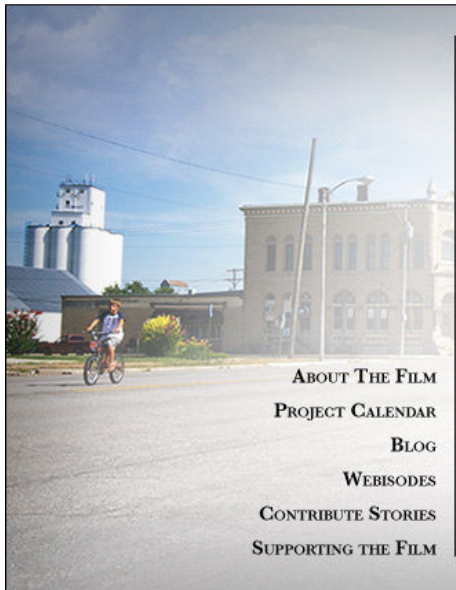

We get asked this almost everyday. No, you do not have to have a reservation in order to join us for lunch, but calling ahead lets us make sure that we can serve you like we like to. We may serve 5 or 50 on any given day. When our guests call ahead, we are more able to have the appropriate number of staff on hand. We do lots of other things in the Bake Shoppe daily. Our baking schedule is lined up for two week ahead. All of the lunch entrees, sides, rolls, cakes and pies are made from scratch, and we do not do fast food, or hamburger and french fries.

I became aware of some of the things that make us different when we were interviewed for a Small Town America documentary. The fellows who interviewed us that day, used the words "A New Model" of serving people. When you join us at Our Daily Bread our menu includes 4 or 5 entrees to choose from. You can also choose from a selection of made from scratch sides, and your choice of our lemon/orange steeped tea, or coffee are included with your meal. If you choose to add dessert to you meal, it is just a minimum cost and you choose from a long list of made from scratch pies, cheesecakes, and delicious dessert. *Join us soon...for lunch...and call ahead!*

Janet,

The park which sits on the corner of Center and 1st Ave. was owned by the I.O.O.F. The Lilly Pool was dedicated on May 6, 1933.

The water was continually fed into the pool and overflowed out into a system of underground laterals, which watered the park. The Shells and Guns where put into the park as a dedication to the WWI Veterans.

The I.O.O.F Park was given to the city of Barnes in 1936 in order to qualify for the WPA Project of the Bandshell. The Bandshell was completed in 1940 and dedicated to Percy Davis, who was instrumental in its construction.
