### Treasures of the Trail... (part 2)

*A trip through the twelve villages of Washington County...*

As you leave the Hollenberg Station, and head west you will come to

**Hollenberg**, the smallest town in the county, boasting thirtyone

residents. Founded by G.H. Hollenberg, in 1872 it was the location of the first store in the county and the village maintains a community well located in the center of the town.

South of Hollenberg is another town founded and laid out by G.H. Hollenberg.

**Hanover** was named after his native homeland, Hanover, Germany. Incorporated in 1872, Hanover is the Pride of the Little Blue Valley and has many historic buildings,

some still in use. The St. Johns Catholic Church, built in 1880, is the oldest church in the County. This historic limestone structure still has original fixtures and a steeple that

stands 110 feet high. Located along Washington Street is the "Western Brewery and Malt House", built in 1870. It operated for 10 years as a saloon/brewery until state

prohibition in 1881 forced it to close. Hanover residents celebrate their heritage each summer with the Hanover Days of '49 celebration and the Pony Express Festival.
