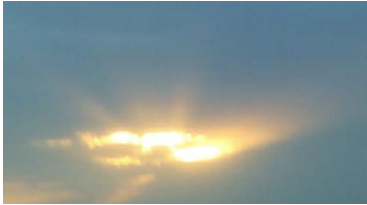

Her music and message were so encouraging at a time that I was struggling with my attitudes about life and motherhood. It was the first time that I came to understand "Singing through the pain." A diving accident in 1967 left Joni a quadriplegic in a wheelchair, unable to use her hands. During two years of rehabilitation, she spent long months learning how to paint with a brush between her teeth. Her high detail fine art paintings and music are inspiring and unique to say the least. Joni's message would be a lesson that I would recall and need at different times in my life, and one that I would share with others.

It has been my experience that all of God's children are ordinary people who have been made extraordinary by the purpose He has given them. The beauty of His kingdom is its growth. The progress of going from strength to strength, from glory to glory. No mis-spent time over failures and shortcomings. Fashioned of joy and sorrow, of failure or success...what does it matter as long as it serves His purpose? The sculptor who finds a faulty marble casts it aside. Because it has no fashioning,

it may regard itself as perfect; and it may look with scorn upon the marble the Sculptor is cutting and shaping into perfection.

I choose each day to let Him have His way. It allows me to find joy in my circumstances.

I am watching, as we all are, with concerns for our nation and leaders. I believe that He is in the whirlwind...and at the outcome, there will be a lesson for all of us...if we let Him have His way. Joni...I plan to sing through the pain...praying and praising Him as I go.

January 1: Closed

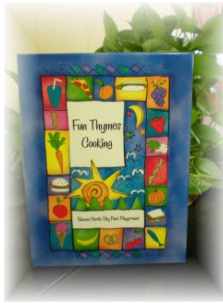

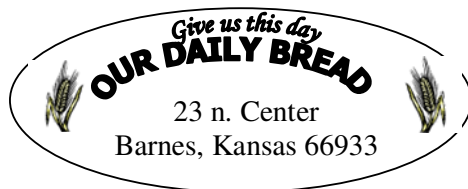
