October is a busy time here in Kansas. There is a short window of time, as the corn and soybeans are harvested and the hard winter wheat that makes such good bread is being planted. I went out to join in all the excitement over the weekend and help move equipment. It was a welcome change from listening to all the financial banking woes, and election politics that have taken over the media. I was reminded again of why I love the country life and the people that are drawn to it. The markets attempt to tell us from day to day if they value our labor and what we produce. Meanwhile....the farmers will put in the crops in due season, and trust the God will bless their efforts. The whole world may be fearful that the sky is falling...but a farmer, keeps on farming. One of my favorite biblical prophets is Jeremiah. I think of him as one of the original experiential teachers. God often asked him to take what seemed like absurd actions to deliver a message to his people. He felt frightened and insecure- but burned with a message that was not comforting or encouraging. The message that "for a world that defies God, He plans judgment. And

no one, not even His chosen messengers will escape suffering. God's presence will make them strong enough to face it. In Jeremiah's time Babylon assembled troops against the remaining Southern Kingdom. Would God save his chosen people? Jeremiah loudly insisted for more than 20 years that God would punish Judah just as he had Israel, by letting Babylon take them into captivity. He lived to see his predictions come true. Just as the king of Babylon was besieging Jerusalem, Jeremiah is to told by God to buy a field. (I am not sure how many of us would have the courage to buy anything in a land being taken over by a conquering army. )

At the very time that what seems like the worst possible events are coming to pass- Jeremiah is assured that they will be coming back. Jeremiah instructed that the deed be placed in a clay jar so it would last a long time. Then God gave Jeremiah a promise:  
*"I will bring them back to this place and let them live in safety. They will be my people, and I will be their God.*

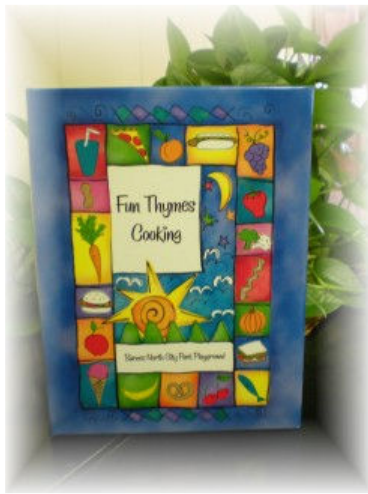

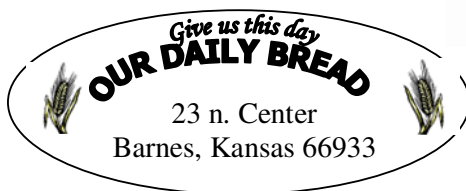
### Benefit for Playground
