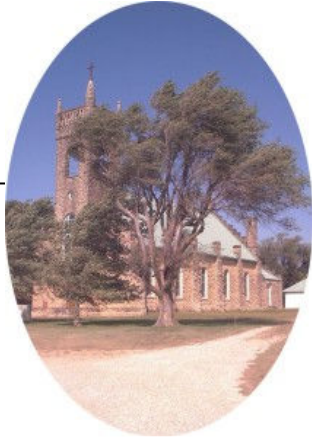


### Treasures of the Trail.... (part 6)

#### Doing Dirt....or discovering treasures by taking that road less traveled.

*As many of you know that regularly travel Highway 77, we are experiencing major road construction on the bridge that crosses Tuttle Creek lake. This has given us the opportunity to encourage you to find some new and less traveled routes around the construction. When you are in a hurry to come up to Barnes for lunch, there is a short cut detour on "Winkler Road" which is highlighted on the attached map. However, please consider taking one of the various other roads that will take you on the scenic route, especially during the fall of the year when everything is so beautiful.*

One of those treasures that you will find is **St. Micheal's Catholic Church** which was built in 1876. This stately limestone structure is a beautiful site on the Kansas plains. It is located at the little settlement of **Kimeo**, located on the blacktop road between Green and Greeleaf. It is a drive by Site, and is not used regularly for services, however- it is used for weddings by special arrangement.
