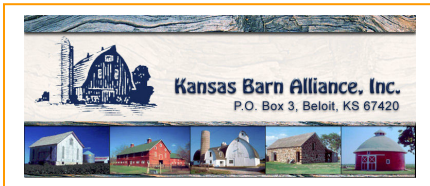

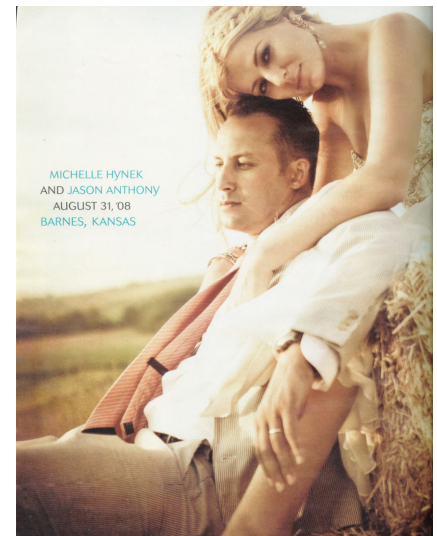
We have been Celebrating a Wedding!
