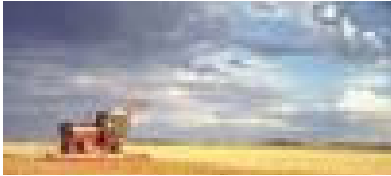

It reminds me of a painting I saw in a farm magazine. It pictured a farmer bent down in the field, checking the germination of a seed of corn. In the background was a rolling cloud with lightning behind it. The caption read "There is no room for Atheists out here!" It has been my observation that rural areas, closely tied to agriculture, are less likely to produce the disconnect in people between producing the food, and what appears on the store shelves.

I believe it has to do with trust. Trust is like a muscle – as you exercise it, trust gets stronger. It is the antidote to anxiety; it's the resolution of worry, and the destruction of fear. Could it actually be good for me to experience stress? To fear not being able to provide for my family? To realize that I have no control over anything...not even over the opening of that little seed. I have found that Trust is the act of my will to give my burdens to God. Trust to me is walking forward moment by moment, having rolled my burden His way. My biggest obstacle is off-loading that burden

to Him ...but then realizing that...here it is again...back in my grip! Again...back on the knees, transfer of burden..., get on my feet again, and continue to trust! See what I mean about exercise...they say what we don't use....we loose! Isaiah 41:10 ends with a visual picture, "I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. " There it is ! He is doing this whole thing with one hand behind His back. He's not stressed or strained. He's not worried about what to do. He has absolutely no capacity limits!!! Wow! The forecast is for clear weather ahead with a chance for rain on Monday....stay well..be Thankful...and see you in the harvest field!
