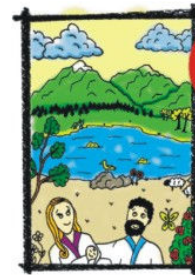

She graduated from Concordia University, River Forest, IL in religious education. In 1970 she married Rudy Kampia. They have 4 children and three grandchildren.

Judy has taught in rural, suburban and inner city schools in 8 states. She has also written Christian Day School, Sunday School and VBS materials. Judy began God's Great Book after seeing the need for a complete and flexible Bible Story and activity book that could be used with multi-age groups of various sizes. 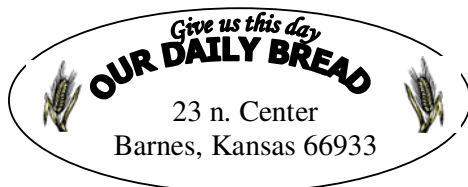
