living/dining area, full kitchen, and 1 bath.*

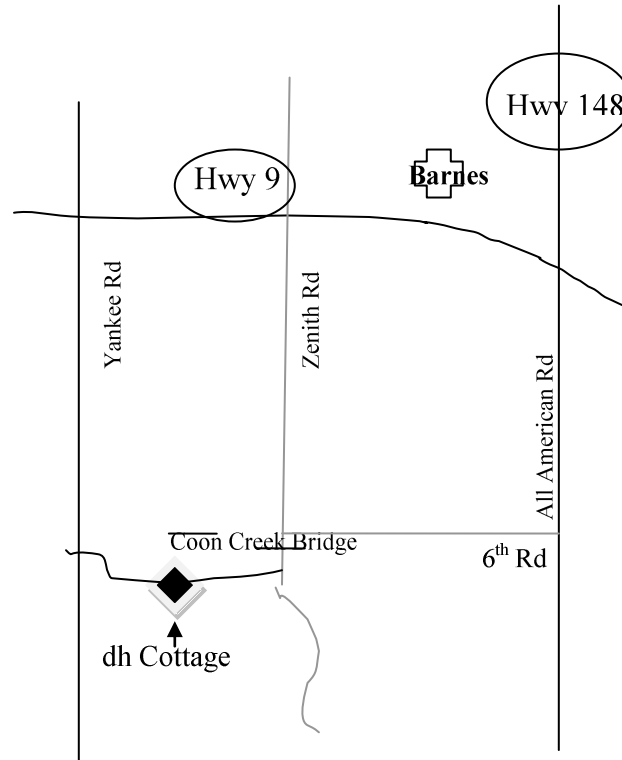
*The lower level has two full beds,

*Wood stove on the upper level and propane*

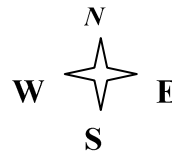
*heat on the lower level.*
